How to Clean the Kitchen Checklist

Supplies	S:		
ABC = antibacterial cleaner 1/2 cup baking soda Broom or vacuum Cloth		Disinfecting spray or wipes Dish soap Light bulbs Mop or scrub brush	Sponge Toothpaste Trash bags 1/2 cup vinegar
Jobs:			
	Replace any burned	out light bulbs	
	Drains: Pour 1/4 cup baking soda down sink drain, then 1/4 cup vinegar. Let sit for 5 minutes. Run hot water down drain to flush through.		
	Put away clean dishes from dish drainer and dishwasher		
	Load dirty dishes into dishwasher and start it (or hand-wash if no dishwasher)		
	Wash all hand-washable dishes		
	Clear off counter(s) and table, put all items in their homes		
	Wash table with antibacterial cleaner (ABC), brush crumbs/food off chairs		
	Replace table linens as needed (tablecloth, placemats, napkins)		
	Restock tabletop items (salt, pepper, straws, paper napkins)		
	Clean stove top with ABC		
	Wipe down counters & countertop items (appliances, canisters, etc.) with \overline{ABC}		
	Clean outside of microwave with ABC, clean inside with vinegar		
	Fill dish soap dispenser		
	Empty the sink's food traps into trash		
	Clean sink with ABC, then rub faucet with toothpaste & cloth to shine		
	Disinfect refrigerator handles, cabinet knobs, light switches & drawer handles		
	Replace dish towels with clean towels		
	Remove dirty laundry (dish towels, linens, bibs)		
	Empty trash and replace bag (make sure extra bags are in the bottom of the trash can)		
	Shake out rugs outside		
	Sweep and/or vacuum (don't forget under cabinets, under table and around trash can)		
	Mop or scrub the floor, then replace rugs
